Peaches are traditional symbols of longevity due to their mystic virtue of bringing immortality to those who eat them. A gift of a peach is a wish for a long and healthy life. The artist frequently looks at traditional culture with a fresh eye. She worked on this playful series at the Chinese imperial kilns in Jingdezhen with the hope that these symbolic objects would touch many. Continued...
