
PAGODA RED

This drum form pedestal was carved from a single block of white marble by Qing-dynasty artisans in the mid-19th century. Ringing both its top and bottom, an etched pattern of nail heads imitates those used to stretch a skin on an actual drum. At the pedestal's center is a flowering chrysanthemum blossom, set in low relief within a simple medallion form. Given their ability to bloom well into cold temperatures, chrysanthemums are symbols of longevity and represent the virtue of endurance in the face of difficult times. Continued...
