A twist on traditional blue-and-white ceramics, rich shades of red decorate this ceramic brush pot with a landscape rendered in the traditional shan shui painting style. Characterized by soft, feathery brushstrokes, the style advocates balance, composition and form to convey nature as a state of mind. Likely part of a scholar's desk, the vessel, which dates from around 1900, would have held brushes for calligraphy and painting.
